Fendels Cable Cars.

Take the cable car up, immerse yourself in stunning nature, and start your adventure relaxed.

The direct bus connection takes you comfortably to the valley station in Ried. From there, the gondola brings you up to Sommerberg Fendels, where exciting adventures await families, hikers, and bikers. Continue with the chairlift to Sattelklause – the perfect spot for a relaxing break. The bus ride is free with the Summercard.

Highlights:

- Exciting mountain cart ride, back to the mid-station.
- Swimming opportunity below the valley station at the Lake.

Did you know, that ...

- there is a bus stop directly at the valley station of the cable car?
- you can bring your bike along on the cable cars?

Tip:
The Summercard GOLD is available at the information offices and ticket counters of the mountain lifts. It offers free access to the lifts and a variety of exclusive discounts.

Hiking pick-up bus.

Hike stress-free, enjoy nature, and comfortably return to your accommodation without a car.

Take the mountain cable cars comfortably up to Fendels. From there, hike along the scenic trail past the stunning Anton-Renk-Waterfall to the cozy Anton-Renk-Hut (unmanned). Continue on the panoramic path to the charming Alpe Stalanz for a cozy break. At the "Spielebene," a 30-minute walk below Alpe Stalanz, the hiking shuttle will pick you up and return to the valley.

Anton-Renk-Hut.

The Anton-Renk-Hut is an unstaffed shelter with unique charm, providing a peaceful retreat.

The hike to the Anton-Renk-Hut delights with stunning views and a breathtaking waterfall just below. From there, you can either take the same path back or continue on to the serviced Alpe Stalanz.

Highlights:

- Anton-Renk-Waterfall below the hut
- Panorama Trail with breathtaking views

- the hut is located in the Glockturm ridge of the Ötztal Alps?
- the hut is surrounded by the mountain peaks Feichtner Karlspitze, Pfroschkopf, Zirmesspitze and Kuppkarlspitze?
- that you can stay overnight in the hut with a prior reservation?

Panorama Trail.

Enjoy the freedom as you walk over wooden foot-bridges and wander along babbling brooks.

The Panorama Trail is beautifully situated between the Anton-Renk via Ferrata and the hiking trail to Alpe Stalanz. It passes right by the Anton-Renk Waterfall and offers breathtaking mountain views.

Large Lake.

From the Anton-Renk-Hut, exciting hiking opportunities await, including the beautiful Large Lake.

The hike to Large Lake offers breathtaking panoramic views but requires good endurance. Walking time from the Anton-Renk Hut is approximately 1.5 hours. This route is recommended for experts.

Samariger Trail.

A picturesque path through alpine meadows and fragrant forest with stunning mountain views.

The Samariger Trail winds through untouched nature, and rewards hikers with breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains. This narrow path leads through alpine terrain, making the hike a special experience.

Highlights:

- Refreshment stops at Sattelklause and Fendler Alm
- Beautiful blooming alpine roses from June until July

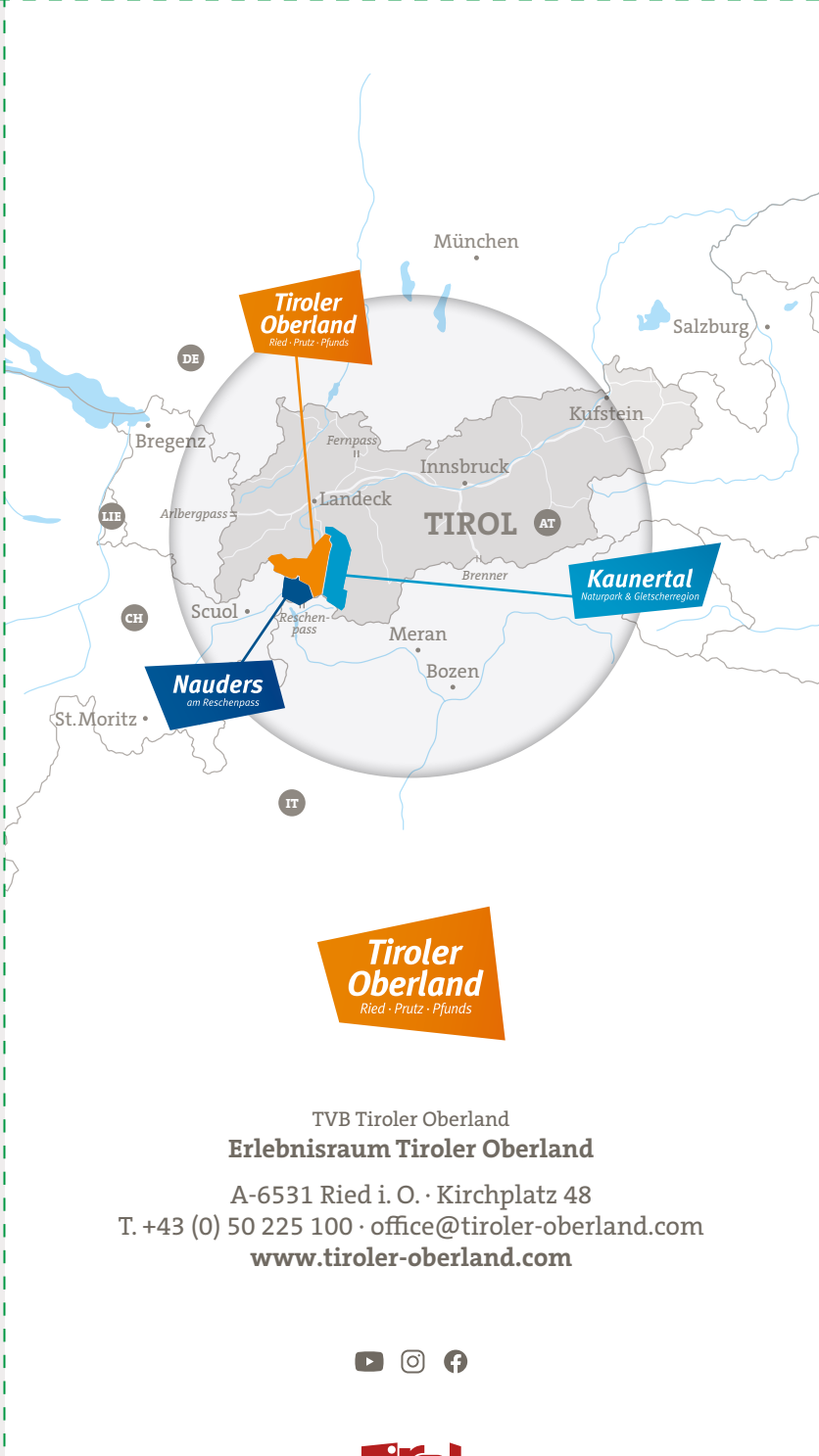
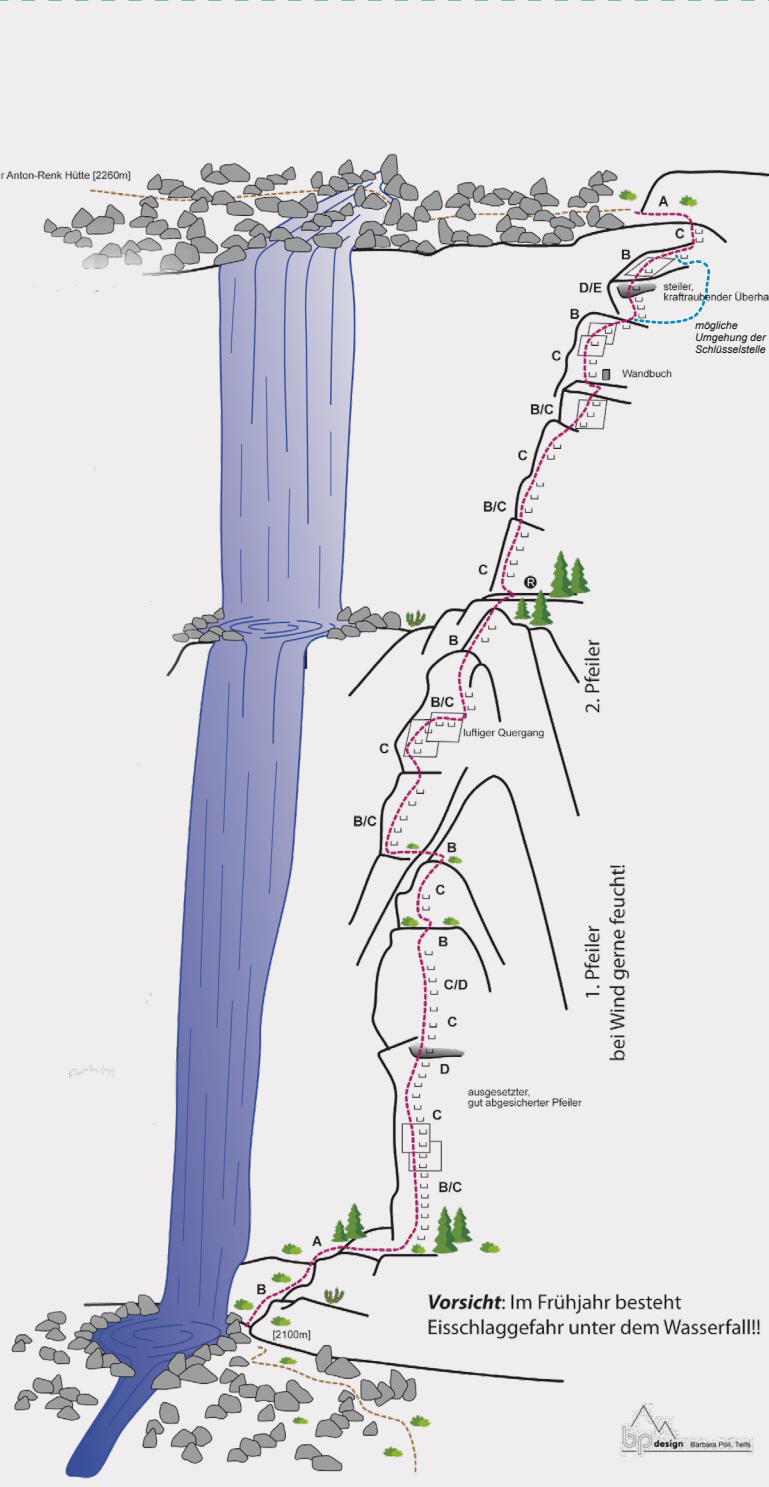
